Medium-deep ruby color, rich, deep cherry aromas with oak notes; rich, full, ripe cherry flavors with spice notes; silky texture, good structure and balance; long finsh. Rich, full Pinot with lots of flavor - great for the grill.

A shining light of bright crimson fills the glass, and the nose is greeted with Asian spice and summer cherries. High acidity and a satin slipperiness offers a luxurious texture. Just a hint of cola, meld with a lovely caramel oak on the finish; a scent that lingers on the nose.
