## Vintage Notes

With abundant early-season rain followed by excellent spring and summer weather, the start of the 2022 growing season was nearly ideal. An intense heat wave, followed by cool rains in September, accelerated ripening but allowed the fruit to reach its fullest potential before being carefully harvested. The early harvest produced grapes with complex, concentrated, fruit-forward flavors and balanced acidity.

## Food Pairings

Savor this grippy wine alongside grilled lamb chops, roasted root vegetables, a beef ragu pasta, or a delightful cheese board featuring aged cheddar, gouda, and a creamy blue cheese.
